## **Discussion Questions**

- How comfortable were you discussing abortion before watching the film? How do you feel about discussing abortion after watching the film?
- How are abortion rights connected to trans rights, bodily autonomy, and, more broadly, all issues of individual civil liberties and social justice?
- Why do we need joy & levity in activism around abortion access now? Is it an effective strategy for action?
- · Discuss how comedy is used in the film.
  - · As an act of resistance
  - · As a tool for educating
  - · As a way to disarm and engage in difficult discussions
  - · As a way of uniting community
- Abortion Access Front is engaged in activism in many ways, like direct protest, clinic support, or exposing fake clinics online. What resonated with you most and why?

## **Action Items**

- **BRAINSTORM**: Do you have a fake clinic near you? Had you ever noticed it prior to watching the film? How can you educate your community about these "clinics"?

- **BRAINSTORM:** Do you have a real clinic near you? How can you support that clinic?
- **BRAINSTORM**: Are there fun things that you and your friends do already that can be turned into a fundraiser for your local clinic, abortion fund or favorite local organization?
- Interested in calling your representatives about issues related to bodily autonomy or other attacks on democracy? Utilize <u>5 calls for easy prompts</u>.
